Founded in 1998, the Association pour la taxation des transactions financières et pour l'action citoyenne (association for taxation of financial transactions and citizen action, or Attac) is an association of activists working for social and environmental justice, who take a radical stance against the power held by the world of finance over communities and nature. Through its actions, Attac promotes and fosters alternatives and works toward establishing citizen control over predatory banks and multinationals. A fixture in over 40 countries, Attac is committed to the ongoing struggle to counter the ravages of neoliberalism. It provides analyses and organizes actions in order to build credible alternatives.
